

engaged in conversation about how she became interested in scrapbooking. I asked her if she would like to hang out with me and have one on one time. Jessica looked up at me with a big smile and asked if we could do girly things together. A few days later we had our first girls night out. We had dinner together and got to know each other better. She asked about my family and what kind of things I liked to do. She was happy to hear that I enjoyed many of the same things she did.

After three or four visits with Jessica I was hooked. This little girl brightened every day I spent with her. The mentor program requires you to spend at least 10 hours a month with your assigned child. We averaged about 50+ hours a month with Jessica because we enjoyed her so much. My husband and I invited Jessica to a duck basketball game. She was an awe-some cheerleader and we sat there in awe witnessing the excitement in this child's eyes. During the mentoring, I was able to help Jessica with her homework and answer common questions about the teenage years. One evening my husband looked at me and said let's adopt Jessica. My first reaction was what in the world, have you gone mad. After some long discussions we started the necessary steps to become Jessica's pre-adoptive parents. She transitioned to our home in June when the school year ended.



I won't lie and say that we haven't had challenges, but the good days far exceed the rough days. It's the best feeling to see this child grow and develop skills that will make a difference in her life. Jessica's quote: I finally found my forever family and home. I'm beginning to learn to trust that my family truly loves me. Sometimes I wake up from a dream and realize that this isn't a dream at all. *Jessica's Mentor and Proud New Mom!!*
