In order to create solid relationships, we would like to find mentors who can spend ten hours a month with a child. If you or someone you know would like to be a mentor, please complete a volunteer application via our website, www.afamilyforeverychild.org. Mentors must complete an online volunteer application, attend a mentor training and orientation, participate in an in home interview, and complete a criminal background check. Mentors are asked to spend at least ten hours a month with their mentee.

Community Outreach Volunteers: A Family For Every Child is looking for community outreach volunteers to promote our mentor program in the Lane County community!
