FIND A CHILD FOR YOUR FAMILY

Set up a Custom Report for your family!
Enter your family's child preferences (ie: age,
gender, siblings or single child, even
characteristics to include or exclude)
This new search option allows you to easily find
children that fall into the preferences for your
families.

FIND A FAMILY FOR YOUR CHILD!

Search for Families that fit the parameters for your
child.

Need a single child household?
Want to match a child with a family of specific
ethnicity?

Do you have siblings to place?
Want to center your search in one state or
geographic area?

All these options may be set to control your
search.

All Reports return child listing information and
worker contact e-mails and/or phone numbers.
Using these reports and the worker directory you
will have access to families with approved home
studies and children's bios with their worker
contact.



Some MAP for Professionals Highlights:

- ***Request recruitment services for children on your caseload*** - this can include webinars where you present your children's information and details about them to home study approved families who have expressed an interest in the type of child(ren) you are presenting.
- ***Quickly photo list a child for in-state or nationwide families to submit on*** - a picture is worth a thousand words. Families are drawn to children on many levels but a picture can tug at the heartstrings most effectively.
- ***Conduct targeted family searches for children on your caseload based on specific family characteristics*** - using MAP you are able to send information about your child(ren) in mass e-mails to home study approved families who fit the criteria for a match.

All families must be home study approved to adopt a child from foster care. We ask that all home study documents be signed and dated. It helps if the family is approved to adopt children out-of-state, but this is not a requirement. In addition, families are asked

to create a family profile on our site. These family profiles are sent out every time a family submits through our site, and are used by the Matching Assistance Coordinator to recruit on the behalf of the family. We serve families from all over the country.

The only people who have access to a family's confidential information are you, the Matching Assistance team, and a child's caseworker. We take a family's privacy very seriously, and their confidential information will never be submitted without their consent or prior knowledge.

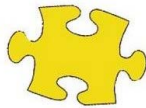
