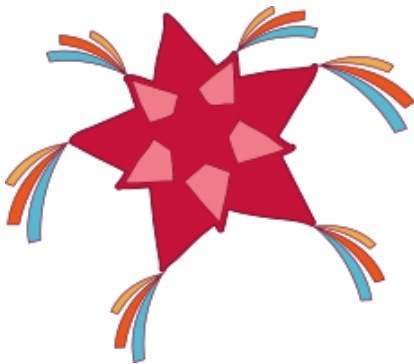




Permanency Newsletter Winter 2017
